

## CIRCULAR

It is for the information of all concerned that henceforth if any Party in Person wants to mention any matter **orally** for urgent directions before the Hon'ble Court pursuant to circulars F.No.145/Judl./2015 dated 14.05.2015 and F.No.145A/Judl./2015 dated 22.05.2015, the Party-in-Person shall have to complete the following procedural aspects:

1. The Party-in-Person shall submit his/her request alongwith an affidavit of urgency and mentioning proforma to the concerned Section.
2. The concerned Section shall issue the clearance in all respects including interaction of the Party-in-Person as required under the Supreme Court Rules, 2013.
3. The Party-in-Person at the first instance shall approach the Mentioning Section for listing the matter in the listed mentioning and the Mentioning Section will examine the matter as per existing guidelines/directions. If the matter is not accepted for listed mentioning on the grounds of no urgency, only then the Party-in-Person can mention the matter orally before the Hon'ble Court, as per the Circular, dated 22-5-2015.
4. The Party-in-Person shall approach the PRO/Security Incharge for issue of entry pass to the Party-in-Person for mentioning the matter **orally** before the Hon'ble Court, if the same is not listed in listed mentioning on the grounds of no urgency.
